Bahrain Polytechnic shall:

- Only admit students who have submitted completed applications that meet approved, published and regularly reviewed General Admission Requirements and Programme Specific Entry Criteria.
- select students who best match the required profile for entry into Bahrain Polytechnic programmes using approved, published and regularly reviewed selection criteria
