Academic Year 2015 - 2016 marks another milestone for AMA International University - Bahrain (AMAIUB). Its registration for the first Trimester is in its full swing with the expected increased number of freshmen, transferees and returning students.

The AMAIUB student population for the first time will be joined by students coming from ECE-Paris because AMAIUB will be receiving its students from the said University in Paris, France as a result of an agreement penned between ECE-Paris and AMAIUB. The agreement signed between the two Universities primarily aim to promote greater mobility, cultural awareness and educational enrichment.

Another first starting this Academic Year is the recognition of the academic achievers. This academic policy on

academic achievers came before the Academic Council on the basis of motivational merits for the exemplary performance of students in their respective programmes.

Qualifying criteria on grants for students who have excelled in their subjects every trimester had been set. The university grants two (2) exemplary merits namely the President's List and the Dean's List.

The President's List qualifies a student who obtains an average of 96 percent and above or A+ with no grade lower than 91 or A. Each student achiever in the President List will receive a 20% grant from tuition fees.

The Dean's List qualifies a student who gets an average of 91 percent and above or A with no grade lower than 86 or A-. Each student achiever in the Dean's List will receive a 10% grant from tuition fees.

Both grants require the students of a Certificate of Good Moral Character from the Office of Students Affairs. They should also carry a regular load of 18 units per trimester.

Meanwhile, AMAIUB has been in more than a decade providing quality and excellent learning in the Kingdom through its programmes that are recognized by the world's prestigious and renowned accreditation agencies in their respective fields.

The University's business programmes namely Bachelor of Science in Business Informatics and Bachelor of Science in International Studies are accredited by European Council for Business Education (ECBE). ECBE is an international organization which ensures that its accredited members satisfy the requirements of the European Higher Education set out in the Bologna Process and other European standards.

The Bachelor of Science in Computer Science is the first private University in the Kingdom to be accredited by ABET (Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology) Computing Accreditation Commission.

The Engineering programmes namely Bachelor of Science in Informatics Engineering and Bachelor of Science in Mechatronics Engineering have been visited by ABET - Engineering Accreditation Commission. The two programmes are still awaiting the result of the visit.

ABET is a recognized U.S. accreditor of college and university programmes in applied sciences, engineering and technology.

With the international accreditations, AMAIUB is fulfilling its mission to produce highly skilled and competent graduates responsive to the socio-economic needs of the Kingdom.
