Foundation and Degree students

Foundation and Degree students must register themselves for classes online. Registration opens by programme (see the timing below) and ends **25**th **February 2016.**

 - o Choose more than one option (CRN).
- 3. **Plan** your timetable using the table on page 21.
- Check your account balance on SSB and pay fees (see Fee payment below). Fees are due before 2pm on 3 March 2016. Late payment of fees will result in a fine.

Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation.

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- o their programme structure requires it;
- o they have a CGPA of 3 or higher, OR
- o are eligible to graduate in that semester.

You must submit an "Application to Increase Semester Credits" form to the SIC at least **one full working day** prior to your Programmes registration release date and time to be processed. Late applications will be processed. No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

- ALL fees must be paid in full before
 2.00pm 3rd March 2016.
- Students with unpaid fees after 3rd March 2016 will have a late fee applied.
 Outstanding fees may be paid during the grace period from 6th to 10th March 2016.
- From 13th March 2016, any unpaid course fees will result in the course registration being dropped; a Finance Hold will be placed on the student account and ALL fees <u>remain due</u> and must be paid in full.

All fees must be paid in full before the student can continue their study in the next semester.

Scholarship students repeating courses are required to pay for those courses before the closing date.


