# **Foundation students**

All foundation students will have their courses registered by the Enrolment department in the Certificate in Academic Preparation (CAP) programme courses. Check your timetable on Self Service Banner (SSB) from 1st September 2016. See your Programme Manager to change - add or drop courses using the "Add & Drop form".

ALL students must check their account balance on SSB and pay course fees owing (see Fee payment below).

# Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation.

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- o their programme structure requires it;
- they have a CGPA of 3 or higher, OR
- o are eligible to graduate in that semester.

You must submit an "Application to Increase Semester Credits" form to the SIC at least one full working day prior to your Programmes registration release date and time to be processed. Late applications will be processed. No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

- Registration in a class is based on the class capacity. Seats are limited, see SSB.
- Bahrain Polytechnic reserves the right to unenrol students from courses that have limited seats and are not a requirement.

#### **Fee Payment**

Students who have completed registration, must pay course fees to the Finance Directorate from 9am to 2.00pm in Building 11.114.

- ALL fees must be paid in full before 2.00pm 20 September 2016.
- Students with unpaid fees after 20<sup>rd</sup> September 2016 will have a late fee applied. Outstanding fees may be paid during the grace period from 21 to 27 September 2016.
- o From 3rd October 2016, any unpaid course fees will result in the course registration being dropped; a Finance Hold will be placed on the student account and ALL fees remain due and must be paid in full.

All fees must be paid in full before the student can continue their study in the next semester.

Scholarship students repeating courses are required to pay for those courses before the closing date. See Heyam Juma in 8.07 for more information.
