Registration and payment process

Based on HEC instructions, the student is not allowed to register in two or more different programmes simultaneously whether in Bahrain Polytechnic or in any other institutes.

Foundation and Degree students

Foundation and Degree students must register themselves for classes online. Registration opens by programme (see the timing below) and ends **8**th **March 2018.**

- Check the list of courses you should register in (from page 13) and/or see your Academic Advisor.
- 2. Check the **Class Schedule** on Self Service Banner (SSB) from 15th February 2018
 - Choose more than one option (CRN).
- 3. **Plan** your timetable using the table on page 21.
- 4. Check your account balance on SSB and **pay fees** (see Fee payment below). Fees are due before 2pm on 15 March 2018. Late payment of fees will result in a fine.

Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation.

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- their programme structure requires it;
- they have a CGPA of 3 or higher,
- are eligible to graduate in that semester.

You must submit an "Application to Increase Semester Credits" form to the SIC at least <u>one</u> <u>full working day</u> prior to your Programmes registration release date and time to be processed. Late applications will be processed. No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

- أن يكون مؤهلاً للتخرج قي نهاية الفصل الذي يرغب في التسحيل فيه

Fee Payment

Online Payment

Tuition fees need to be paid online only starting from:

- Online payment will be open from 20
 February at 9am until 15 March at 2pm.

 Online payment will be closed on 15 March at 2pm.
- Students with unpaid fees after 15 March 2018 will have a late fee applied. Outstanding fees may be paid during the grace period from 18 March at 12pm to 22 March 2018 at 2:00pm.
- From 25 March 2018, any unpaid course fees will result in the course registration being dropped; a Finance Hold will be placed on the student account and ALL fees <u>remain due</u> and must be paid in full.

All fees must be paid in full before the student can continue their study in the next semester.

Scholarship students repeating courses are required to pay for those courses before the closing date.
