Based on HEC instructions, the student is not allowed to register in two or more different programmes simultaneously whether in Bahrain Polytechnic or in any other institutes.

Foundation and Degree students

Foundation and Degree students must register themselves for classes online. Registration opens by programme (see the timing below) and ends **25**th **February 2021.**

- Online workshop will be available for Foundation students on 6th February on how to register in courses online
- Check the list of courses you should register in (from page 13) and/or see your Academic Advisor.
- 3. Check the **Class Schedule** on Self Service Banner (SSB) from 4th February 2021
 - Choose more than one option (CRN).
- 4. **Plan** your timetable using the table on page
- Check your account balance on SSB and pay fees (see Fee payment below). Fees are due before 2pm on 3 March 2021.

Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation.

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- their programme structure requires it;
- they have a CGPA of 3 or higher, OR
- are eligible to graduate in that semester.

You must submit complete "Application to Increase Semester Credits" online form at least one full working day prior to your Programmes registration release date and time to be processed. Late applications will be processed. No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

يجب أن تتوافر الشروط التالية في الطلبة الراغبين في تسجيل 75 ساعة معتمدة:

- •اذا كانت من متطلبات انهاء البرنامج
- •أن لا يقل المعدل التراكمي لا يقل عن 3 أو أكثر
 - أن يكون مسجلاً في آخر فصل التخرج.

يجب على الطلبة استكمال استمارة "طلب زيادة الساعات المعتمدة للفصل الدر اسي" الإلكترونية قبل يوم عمل واحد على الأقل من بدء التسجيل الخاص بالبرنامج. سنتم زيادة عدد الساعات إذا تمت الموافقة، في حين لا يوجد ضمان لوجود مقاعد شاغرة في المقررات في حالة تقديم الطلب متأخرًا.

Important:

- BILM students can take either TL7001 International Transport Law or <u>BU7003 Business Law</u> (pending approval) Students who have already passed TL7001 will NOT be able to take BU7003



- TL7303 Urban Public Transport is now a **level 8** course TL**8**303. Students who have already passed TL7303 will NOT be able to take TL8303
- TL8405 Airport Management is a new BILM option. All 2018+ students must take additional Level 8 courses as part of the completion requirements and initial registration into this course will be restricted to those students. Students who need to take TL7200 next semester in order to graduate, will be able to take this course instead.
- The above is a guide only. In Semester 2 2020-21 **ALL** the above courses will be offered (except TL7001 and TL7200).
- Students must NOT skip English courses to avoid delaying their expected graduation date.
- All students are strongly encouraged to re-take any courses that they have previously failed (or failed to complete).
- BILM students will have access to <u>BU6005 Accounting</u> courses in Semester 2. This course is NOT offered to BILM students in Semester 1.
- It is the students' responsibility to manage their National Requirement courses and Elective credits. They should follow the academic advice given to them and take these courses when they are offered. <u>Leaving these courses to</u> the end of your studies can delay your graduation.
- All BILM (TL) courses will be delivered differently next semester. Students will have to register into **two** CRNs per course; one CRN for the <u>content-delivery session</u> (max. 60 students) and one CRN for the <u>workshop</u> (max. 20 students):



Please note, we are expecting to continue with online delivery next semester due to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis.
 However, if/when you are allowed to return to campus, then the 'Applied Learning Tutorials' can be delivered face-to-face in classrooms. The Content Delivery sessions will remain ONLINE regardless.

- All students who passed <u>EN6907</u> are required to enrol in <u>EN6914.</u>
- All students who failed **EN6907** are required to enrol in **EN6907** again this semester and **NOT in EN6914**
- Students can choose to enrol in **EN6990 or EN6903** in semester 2, these courses will run in both semester 1 and semester 2.
- Students can choose to enrol in **EN6000 or EN6010** in semester 2, these courses will run in both semester 1 and semester 2.
- Repeating students **MUST** give priority to enrol in courses they have failed.
- If you are a foundation transfer students, give priority to enrol in **EN6907**

e.g. if a student enrolled in EN6990 in semester 1, the same student shall enrol in EN6903 in semester 2, and the student who enrolled in EN6903 in semester 1, shall enrol in EN6990 in semester 2.
