#### Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation from **28 August to 7 September.** 

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- their programme structure requires it;
- they have a CGPA of 3 or higher, OR
- are eligible to graduate in that semester.

You must submit complete "Application to Increase Semester Credits" online form on published dates. Late applications will be processed. No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

#### **Common First Year in Engineering**

Year 1 in Engineering is a common year between Mechanical, Electronics and Electrical Engineering. All engineering students must undertake all courses.

#### For Foundation students: students coming to Engineering degree in semester 1 from foundation:

- 1- Students are strongly advised to give priority to enrol in Mathematics for Engineers 1 (EN6907).
- 2- Students are strongly advised to give priority to enrol in English courses of the first year.
- 3- Students are eligible to enrol in year one courses depending on available capacity in each class.
- 4- Students are not allowed to enrol in Mathematics for Engineers 2 (EN6914).

#### For other student: Year 1 students, students are required to enrol in 60 credits per semester:

- English: ALL Students are required to enrol in <u>EL5005 or EL5006</u> (Unless exempt by English department), repeating students must give priority to enrol in failed course and get advise from the English department.
- ALL students are required to enrol in **EN6907**
- Students can choose to enrol in **EN6000 or EN6903** in semester 1, these courses will run in both semester 1 and 2. Student will be required to alternate in the second semester.
- Students can choose to enrol in **EN6903 or EN6010** in semester 1, these courses will run in both semester 1 and 2. Student will be required to alternate in the second semester.
- Repeating students **MUST** give priority to enrol in failed courses.

e.g. if a student enrols in EN6000 in semester 1, the same student will enrol in EN6903 in semester 2, and the student who enrols in EN6903 in semester 1, will enrol in EN6000 in semester 2.


