#### Registration and payment process

All students MUST register for courses and pay fees OR apply for a Leave of Absence before the end of week 1.

Based on HEC instructions, the student is not allowed to register in two or more different programmes simultaneously whether in Bahrain Polytechnic or in any other institutes.

#### **Foundation and Degree students**

Foundation and Degree students must register themselves for classes online. Registration opens by programme (see the timing below) and ends 23th February 2023.

  - Choose more than (CRN)one option (check the courses timetabel befeor one day of your registration)
- 4. Plan your timetable using the table on page 21.
- 5. Check your account balance on SSB and pay fees (see Fee payment below). Fees are due before 2pm on 1 March 2023.

#### Registering for more than 65 credits

All students can register up to 65 Credits if they are not on Probation.

Students can register up to 75 Credits IF:

- their programme structure requires it;
- they have a CGPA of 3 or higher, OR
- are eligible to graduate in that semester.

"Application to Increase Semester Credits" online form will be open from 4pm to 10pm on 15 to 18 February). No guarantee of a place in any class is given.

- \*\*Register in elective or national requirements courses if Logistic courses are full
- TL7303 Urban Public Transport is now a level 8 course TL8303.
- Students who have already passed TL7303 will NOT be able to take TL8303
- All 2018+ students must take additional Level 8 courses as part of the completion requirements and initial registration into this course will be restricted to those students.
- Students must NOT skip English courses to avoid delaying their expected graduation date.
- All students are strongly encouraged to re-take any courses that they have previously failed (or failed to complete).
- BILM students will have access to <u>BU6005 Accounting</u> courses in Semester 2.

It is the students' responsibility to manage their National Requirement courses and Elective credits. They should follow the academic advice given to them and take these courses when they are offered. Leaving these courses to the end of your studies can delay your graduation.

Some BILM (TL6000, TL6001, TL6300, TL6302 and TL6303) courses will be delivered as seminar and workshop. Students will have to register into two CRNs per course; one CRN for the <u>content-delivery session</u> and one CRN for the workshop.

# **Guidelines for Enrolling in English Courses FOBL: Business and Logistics**

- If you have just completed Foundation English, you can enroll in EL5002.
- If you have completed or not completed EL5001, you can enroll in EL5002.
- If you have completed both EL5001 and EL5002, you should enroll in EL6003.
- If you have completed EL6003, you should enroll in EL6005.
- If you have completed one or two of the five-credit courses (EL6401, EL6402 & EL6403), you should take the remaining five-credit course(s). Note that EL6401, EL6402 & EL6403 will be run for the last time.

Year 1 Semester 2: students are required to enrol in 60 credits per semester:

- English: ALL Students are required to enrol in <u>EL5005 or EL5006</u> (Unless exempted by English department), repeating students must take advice from English department.
- All students who passed **EN6907** are required to enrol in **EN6914**.
- All students who failed **EN6907** are required to enrol in **EN6907** again this semester and **NOT in EN6914**
- Students can choose to enrol in <u>EN6990 or EN6903</u> in semester 2, these courses will run in both semester 1 and semester 2.
- Students can choose to enrol in **EN6000** or **EN6010** in semester 2, these courses will run in both semester 1 and semester 2.
- Repeating students **MUST** give priority to enrol in courses they have failed.
- If you are a foundation transfer students, give priority to enrol in **EN6907**
